Admission Rules to Undergraduate Course 2024-2025

1. The online admission process would be done based on merit points.
2. The admission to the 4 year Honours and 3 year Multidisciplinary programme courses is to be made online.
3. Verification of documents will be done only when the students report for classes in due course. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted online. This is according to the rule of the Government of West Bengal and Vidyasagar University.
4. Admission to any course of the college is provisional and is subject to the final approval of the Vidyasagar University.
5. Anti-ragging declaration as mandated by the UGC is to be furnished online by every student and his/her guardian after admission.
6. Caste Certificates (whenever applicable) issued only by appropriate authority of the Government of West Bengal will be considered valid. Percentage of reservation to each reserved category follows the G.O. No. 339-Edn (CS)/OM-74L/2023 dated 26.05.2023 of Government of West Bengal, Higher Education Department.
7. The candidates who have taken admission elsewhere are allowed to take admission to this college provisionally. However, transfer certificate or admission cancellation certificate from the previous institution must be submitted within the stipulated time as fixed by the College. Admission to this college otherwise may be treated as cancelled.
8. Candidate who are registered to Vidyasagar University earlier are requested to submit registration cancellation certificate during verification process.
9. Candidate who are registered to college or university other than Vidyasagar University are requested submit registration cancellation certificate during verification process.

Courses Offered

- ▶ **Four year Single Major (B.A. Hons):** Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Santali, Sociology, Philosophy, History and Political Science.
- ▶ **Four year Single Major (B.Sc. Hons):** Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics.
- ▶ **Three year Multidisciplinary Programmes:** Humanities, Physical Science.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council in the year (2024/2023/2022) are eligible to apply.
2. Candidate who has passed in 5(Five) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.
3. For 4 year Single Major course the candidates must have passed with at least 45% marks in Aggregate# or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.
4. The subjects or allied subjects required for admission in 4 year Single Major courses are as follows

Note

- # Aggregate is calculated by the sum of the highest five marks in different subjects in 10+2 examination.
- If the total Marks of any Board or Council other than the West Bengal Council Higher Secondary Education is less or more than 500, then the total number obtained by the candidates of that Board or Council will be extrapolated.
- Marks secured by WBCHSE candidates in Environmental Studies which is a compulsory subject will not be counted for calculating Aggregate# and merit score.
- Admission will be conducted strictly on the basis of merit. The subject wise merit list will be prepared based on 'merit points' for all

categories of students.

- *The number obtained in the subject or in the first language which is highest, will be considered in the merit point calculation.

Tie Breaking Rule

Selection will be done on the basis of higher marks in 1st Language if there is tie in Merit points.
